
Stéphane Billot



BUG BUG BUG



"Stéphane Billot is an artist who "hijacks" norms, signs or values to interrogates the borders between art and everyday lite, art and social interactions ... It could be define as an interstitial practice.

(...)

If the theme of furtive is a common theme in the work of Stéphane Billot, it is the "unseen" that is also involved: not what is invisible but what is hidden, at the margins , not taken into consideration. So these propositions question the edge, the periphery, aesthetic, geographical but also human.

(\dots). His work bring a new perspective to the "unseen" and a discreet as well as radical practice.





























This work was created during a one week residency in a camping. It deals with alternative housing, trip and exile.

Loyalty cards created with false identities.

The names on these cards are all the members of the Situationist International, an international organization of social revolutionaries made up of avant-garde artists, intellectuals, and political theorists.

Situationnist methods (as "détournement") are here used with humor.

Two opposites world (a corporation and a revolutionnary organization) are mixed to create a conceptual "bug", a paradoxical monument.

The serial presentation also deals with the methods of this corporation (illegal recordings and surveillance of workers, political files...)



Somebody keeps static, arms stretched out, in the middle of a Dublin street. This performance is an explicit reference to an action realized place Wenceslas in Prague in 1976 by Jiri Kovanda, but it is transposed in a busy street of Dublin. This action creates forced interactions that disrupt the daily flow of passersby. It interrogates the present and the legacy of this contextual artistic gesture. https://vimeo.com/175428492

RENOVATION URBAINE (URBAN RENEWAL)

We paint garbages in a gold color and fake road signage with young people of an underpriviliged area. An inhabitant accidentally creates a waterfall of blue painting. These actions take place in a context of urban renewal.



C'EST BIEN PEINT (THAT'S WELL PAINTED)

7 photographs mounted on PVC, variable dimensions 2016











This project was realized in a Roma slum in France with inhabitants. For a month and every week, we painted the same stones with the same color. Rain, humidity...and fire erase the work between workshops.

This struggle against the elments, as obstinate as absurd, has created ephemeral deposits of precious stones that creates a dialogue between painting and context.

This model reproduced a hut.

This small volume remains us the models created by architects. The format can also evoke souvenir houses sold to tourists.

The 3D visual refers to billboards of real estate agency announcing future constructions.

In this case instead of announcing what will be, the 3D visual shows the past. It archives what was destroyed: an ephemeral construction of a urban slum in France.

The result is a hybrid and acid object, which reverses norms related to spatial planning.

I put a mirror on a makeshift hut in a urban slum in France.

I used different point of view to connect different spaces/contexts in the same picture. Different landscapes are gradually integrated in the shelter : "nature", slums, and office buildings

This system creates a spatial narration which deals with housing and town planning.

This work is presented on a kind of construction sign made of a wood frame and plywood.

Instead of announcing, it's an archive of a destroyed urban slum

DIY weapons created with different materials. Each weapon, by the materials used and the mode of production chosen, evokes a specific profession (metalworker, baker, plumber, carpenter, etc.) but also prison weapons.

.Workers in a chemical and metallurgical plant pose in front of their workstations, with accessories that can sum up their main hobby during their free time.

The concept of "free time" is questioned, related to the working time, which conditions it, while diverting the codes of the corporate photo.











OUTSIDERS

These illegal actions take place in an industrial bakery, realized by some people from the staff, during working time, with the companys equipment, between several CCTV cameras.

It is an answer to the alienating routine of work and a revenge against the social violence of the company.

Employees hijack and reclaim the production tools, interrogating borders between work and leisure, art and everyday lite.

Actions are archived using mobile phones.

The "sculptures" are, after cooking, thrown into the outside bin. They are often recovered and eaten.







A4 format documents, origamis variable dimensions 2010






These performances were realized during a job in a library
